SURFACE PREPARATION

New Surfaces: Surface/s must be thoroughly clean, dry and in sound condition before painting.

Concrete/Cement Plaster: Apply one coat of Artisan 747 Filler Cote and wait 4-6 hours, then apply two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats.

Asbestos/Fibre Cement: Apply one coat of Artisan 747 Filler Cote and wait 4-6 hours, then apply two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats.

Iron & Steel: Apply one coat of Panache Anti-Corrosive Primer and wait 4-6 hours, followed by one coat of Artisan Universal Undercoat and wait 16 - 18 hours, then apply two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats. Timber/Wood: Apply one coat of Panache Wood Primer-White and wait 16 - 18 hours, followed by one coat of Artisan Universal Undercoat and wait 16 - 18 hours, then apply two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats. Gypsum Plaster (Rhinolite/Rhinoglide): Apply one coat of Artisan Plaster Primer, then apply two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with the correct drying times between coats.

PREVIOULSLY PAINTED SURFACES

Thoroughly clean and prepare surface by removing all dirt, grease, grime and flaking paint before painting. Powdery surfaces must be treated with one coat of Panache Bonding Liquid and wait 16 - 18 hours, prior to applying two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats. Enamel based surfaces must be cleaned and prepared correctly. Sand lightly and apply one coat of Artisan Universal Undercoat and wait 16 - 18 hours, followed by two coats of your desired Artisan Topcoat with correct drying time between coats.

APPLICATION

Stir the contents thoroughly before use. This product should be applied without thinning. For colour consistency, ensure that batch numbers are the same on all cans. Apply this product with a paintbrush or (furpile / lambswool) paint roller and allow 4-6 hours drying time between coats. Allow paint to cure (hard dry) for 7 days before attempting to clean the surface. Do not apply when rain is imminent. Clean tools (brushes & rollers) with Water immediately after use.
